



Urban pattern 1960 - suburbanisation






Urban pattern 2016 - reurbanisation





- ▶ The port covers almost 10%


City state Hamburg's government and administration



- ▶ Hamburg as a city state is both a municipality and one of the federal states of Germany.
- ▶ The Bürgerschaft is Hamburg's state parliament.
- ▶ Ministerial duties in Hamburg are performed by the currently eleven Ministries, each headed by a Senator.
- ▶ Hamburg breaks down into seven administrative districts in charge of local government duties.
- ▶ Each district is headed by a District Council Executive; an elected district council participates in the administration of the district.
- ▶ Comprehensive / strategic urban development for the entire city is a responsibility of the Ministries, while the districts are in charge of local binding plans

- ▶ approximately 1,90 million inhabitants in 2030









Principles for the dense, urban and versatile city




1. Improving the urban character and keep a green metropolis

7. Take Hamburg's energy transition as opportunity for innovation

9. Together for "more city in the city" – with transparency, communication and continuous exchange to get more quality in the city for everyone








Hamburg Metropolitan Region

Non-formal cooperation body



- ▶ Hamburg is the core of the metropolitan region
- ▶ It covers parts of the federal states
 - Schleswig-Holstein
 - Lower Saxony and
 - Mecklenburg-Western Pommerania
- ▶ Including 17 counties and more than 1000 municipalities
- ▶ population of about 5.5 million
- ▶ Informal cooperation; single cross border (federal states) cooperation in Germany
- ▶ Funding system for regional project activities and concepts
- ▶ No planning responsibilities !


